

TO THE PHOTOGRAPHER

1. Smoking is not permitted in any of our church buildings.
2. It is suggested that you arrange with the bride to take as many pictures as possible prior to 45 minutes before the ceremony.
3. No camera flash bulbs may be used during the actual ceremony. One flash picture is allowed as the bride enters the sanctuary and one as she and the groom exit the ceremony.
4. The wedding is a worship service. The taking of pictures, movies, or videos should not distract from this in any way.
5. The photographer must inform the wedding party if any pictures are to be made immediately following the ceremony. This will assure the wedding party's immediate return to the sanctuary.
6. Remember that guests will be waiting for the reception. The photographer and bride should plan in advance the list of shots to be made.
7. The photographer must bring a protective cloth if he plans to stand on the pews or other furniture to take pictures.
